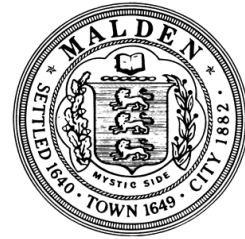

*In accordance with the requirements of Chapter 166 of the General Laws, you are hereby notified that the Malden City Council will hold a virtual public hearing at 5:30 P.M. on Tuesday, **May 4, 2021** on petitions from Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon, 118 Flanders Road, Westborough, MA*

Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon – Installation of necessary telecommunication equipment and corresponding aerial fiber optic cable on National Grid owned Utility Poles; Verizon also to install antennae and appurtenant equipment and aerial fiber route; To collocate small wireless facilities (also referred to as “small cells” on existing wooden utility poles located within the public right of way at the following locations:

If you wish to remotely participate in the public comment portion of the hearing:

Using Zoom:

While in the Zoom meeting, click on the "Q&A" button, then click "Ask Question." In the question box that is shown, enter your full name and your home address for the record. This will give the host a timestamped request that you want to speak and we will respond to these requests during the public comment section of the hearing in the order they were received. When it is your turn to speak, a host will announce your name and will unmute your line and allow you to speak.

Dialed In to Phone Conference Only:

*If you are unable to join the Zoom online meeting and are dialed in by phone only and you would like to participate, press *9 on your phone which will indicate a "raised hand" to the meeting administrator. When it is your turn to speak, the meeting administrator will unmute your line and announce the last 4 digits of your phone number to confirm. You must then announce your name and home address for the record.*
