1. 2023 Election Calendar

Ms. Fajardo explained that the calendar is built with a formula based on State law, City ordinance, and Malden Charter.

2. Updated polling locations for 2023

The Board recommends utilizing the same polling locations as we used in 2022 while implementing the few changes made between September's Primary and November's Election.

3. Procedures for early voting and vote by mail

The Board wishes to opt into early voting this municipal season but with a low turnout expected for early voting, it is recommended to apply it only to normal City Hall business

hours with the location being the City Clerk's Office. Dates of early voting will be October 23-26 and October 31 – November 2.
