PROCEDURAL HISTORY (Case #14-08):

- 1. Petitioner is the owner, Amerco Real Estate Company, 2727 North Central Avenue, 5-N, Phoenix, AZ 85004.
- 2. The petition seeks a special permit under §300.3.5.7, Chapter 12, Revised Ordinances of 1991, as Amended, of the City of Malden, to allow a self-storage facility in the Industrial 1 zoning district, namely, a new four-story building for use as a U-Haul storage and moving center, with a self-storage facility on the second, third and fourth floors and retail sales and services, including vehicle, truck and trailer rentals, on the first floor.
- 3. The public hearing complied with the statutory notice requirements of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40A, §11.
